Basic math, general awareness — these things might become obsolete <sup>information</sup> ~~information~~ since it will not be necessary to retain <sup>it</sup> ~~it~~ <sup>them</sup> in human brain. Nevertheless, the results produced by Chat GPT cannot be overestimated ~~as~~ as quite often the quality of its work is incomparable to that of human. The texts might appear mechanic ~~and~~ dull, which is an indicator that ~~it~~ <sup>were</sup> ~~are~~ not ~~is~~ created by a person, therefore, students will not ~~always~~ ~~be able~~ to use it in a straightforward way. In addition, restrictive measures can be introduced, prohibiting the usage of Chat GPT during lessons and encouraging students to think critically themselves.
