Nowadays, Chat GPT has become an issue of a heated discussion. Many people are concerned that its wide usage may result in a decline of intelligence and a crisis in the educational system.

On the one hand, critics of Chat GPT do have a point. Having a wide set of functions, AI systems are able to complete various academic tasks. It significantly reduces the amount of work people have to do which means that the next generation may lose skills of analyzing and structuring information. Moreover, the implementation of Chat GPT into the educational process implies that the way students are taught should be reformed.
