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ТВОРЧЕСКОЕ ЗАДАНИЕ

With the advent of Chat GPT, the belief that its further advancement can have a negative impact on the educational process is becoming more popular than ever.

On the one hand, there is some truth to this argument. Chat GPT is capable of combining decent texts on a wide range of topics which seriously alleviates the process of completing creative tasks for those who usually have difficulty dealing with them.

On the other hand, if used correctly, Chat GPT can actually boost our critical thinking, and enhance the whole educational sphere. Since it has access to an enormous data base, it can provide us with ideas we most likely would not think of ourselves. We can also use it to show how to ~~write a good~~ creative fulfil creative tasks successfully by analysing how it works and texts produced by it can be used as samples. Finally, Chat GPT is invaluable for self-studying, for it is able to create tasks itself, act as a conversational partner, correct ~~to~~ some of ~~your~~ ^{our} mistakes and so on.

Taking everything into consideration, Chat GPT is just a new stage of AI development. If we deploy its useful functions and treat it reasonably, ~~it~~ can actually benefit our educational system and critical thinking in particular rather than harm them.
