Chat GPT is an AI tool, meant to help people with tasks that include writing detail^d essays, finding answers to various problems and generating unique ideas. Created to help, this ~~pre~~ engine, however, can lead to real data strophy.

But how can a harmless AI bring so many problems?

The problem isn't in CHAT GPT itself. It all depends on who uses it and how. Artificial Intelligence under no circumstances should come in contact with the learning process. Teachers shouldn't use it to teach their students, just as students shouldn't use it to think for them. "But what's ~~the~~ ^{the problem} ~~wrong~~ with that? Wasn't AI created for a problem solving purpose?" - one might ask. Well, this statement is both correct and incorrect.

Yes, Chat GPT was made solely for the purpose of solving problems and finding answers. It might help an old lady with finding a good pie recipe by analysing countless recipes online. But when you're passing a test or doing your homework, you're supposed to use your own brain, therefore expanding your knowledge and skillset. This is the purpose of learning: becoming a better, smarter person with critical thinking.

Mindless copying does not contribute to this.
