In conclusion, everyone is responsible for the food waste and must make a contribution to overcome this issue.

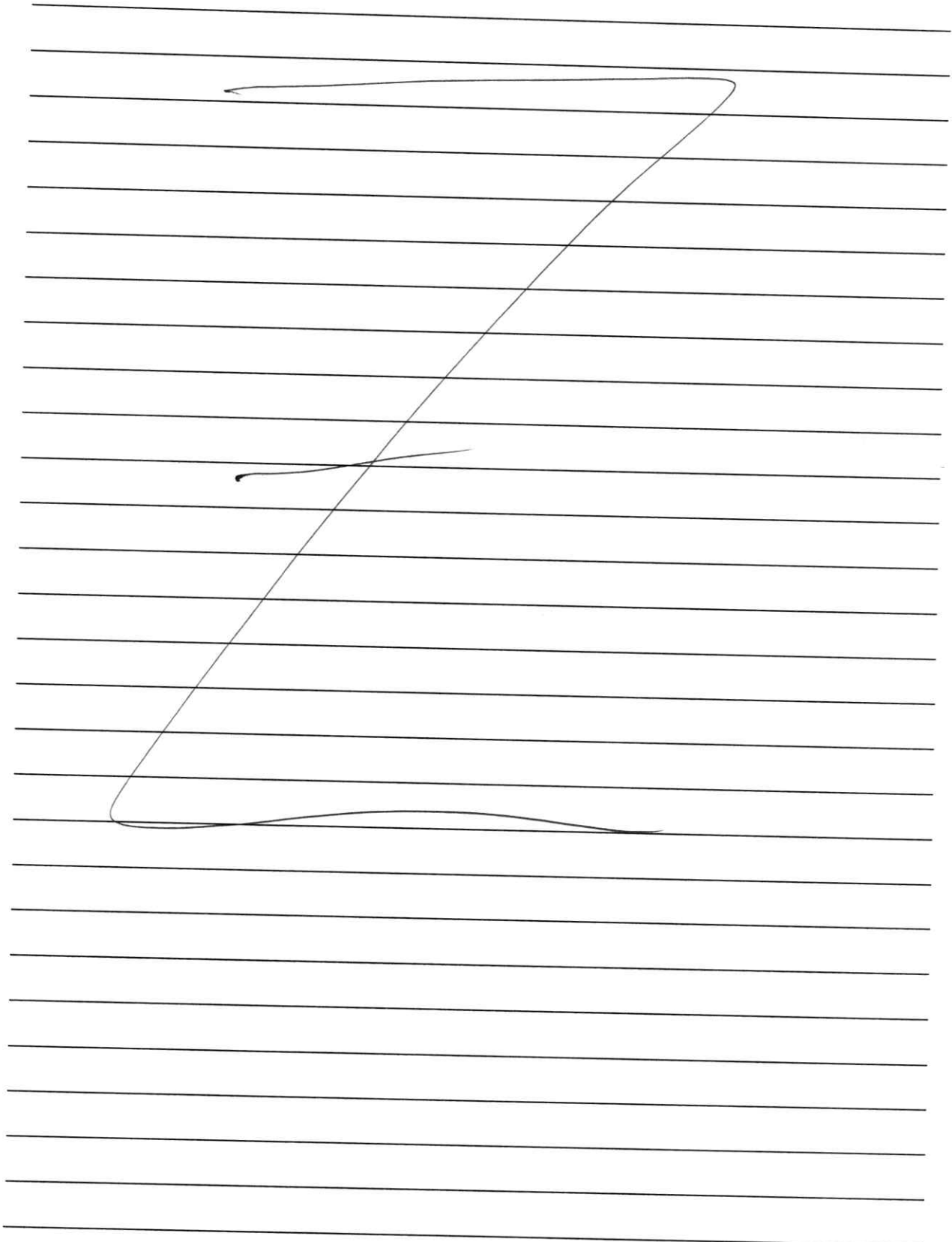
