In the last 5 years due to the rapid advancements in the development of AI, it has become quite widespread. Many people are worried that AI will soon come to take their jobs, and for good reasons as in several private companies a lot of workers have already been replaced by AI.

The main reason for this is the current economic system under which we exist. The goal of any private company is to maximize profit, therefore rather than paying qualified designers for their labour they will choose the much cheaper alternative which is AI.
