Nowadays, it is nearly impossible to spend 10 minutes online without stumbling upon at least one mention of Artificial Intelligence. There are constant talks about AI in the press, on online forums, in advertisements... - everywhere, it seems. AI is indeed taking over the ~~AI~~ globe, but why?

I believe there are several reasons behind it. The most obvious one is that AI can easily handle tasks people would find mind-numbingly boring, like writing a CV or scanning an email for misspellings. Why bother wasting hours on something a machine can do in a minute?

However, a more sinister reasoning behind the rise of AI is lurking just under the surface: human beings are becoming less profitable for companies. Undoubtedly, assigning the work of, for example, reviewing job applications to a bot is much cheaper than hiring a couple of people, paying them monthly at least the minimum wage, providing them sick leaves and holidays and having them ultimately retire.

Although Artificial Intelligence's usage might at first appear non-threatening, but with the time the importance of restricting ~~the~~ AI becomes obvious. I reckon governments shouldn't turn a blind eye to the rising issue: laws ought to be created to prevent harm from being done. Not disclosing using AI, showcasing generated images of a product, creating deepfakes - all of it should be
