All these measures would lead to more food balance, and I could be finally proud.

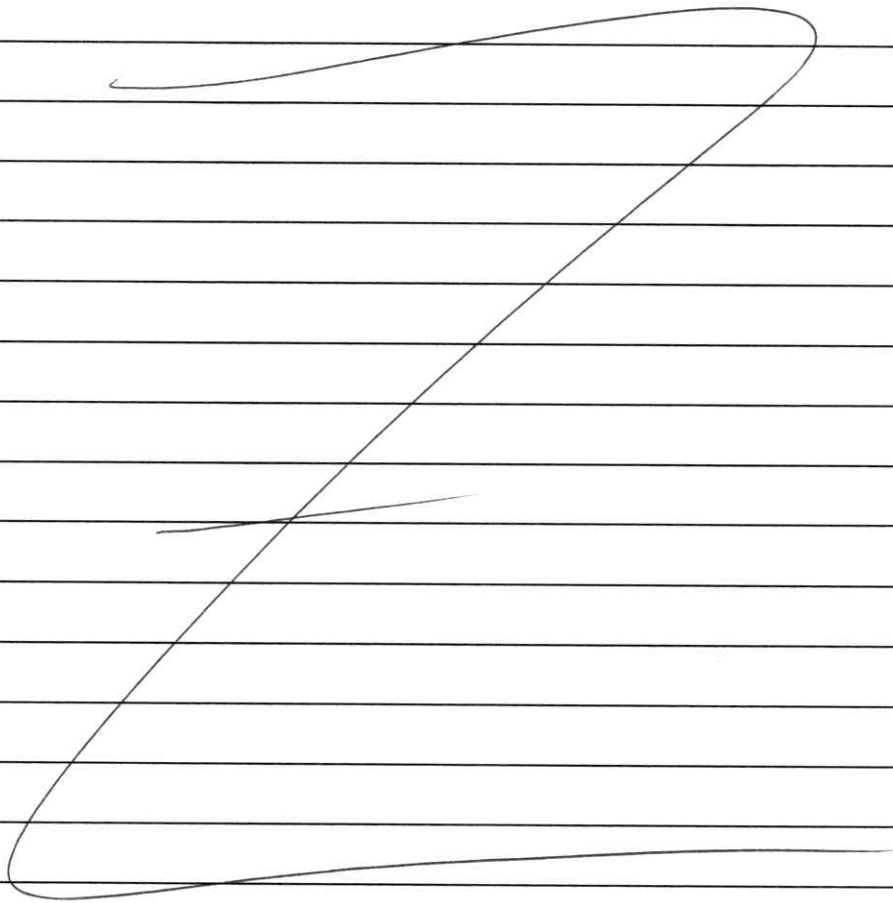
