To sum up, throwing food away is really bad but common. And I hope that more people will stop doing it soon.

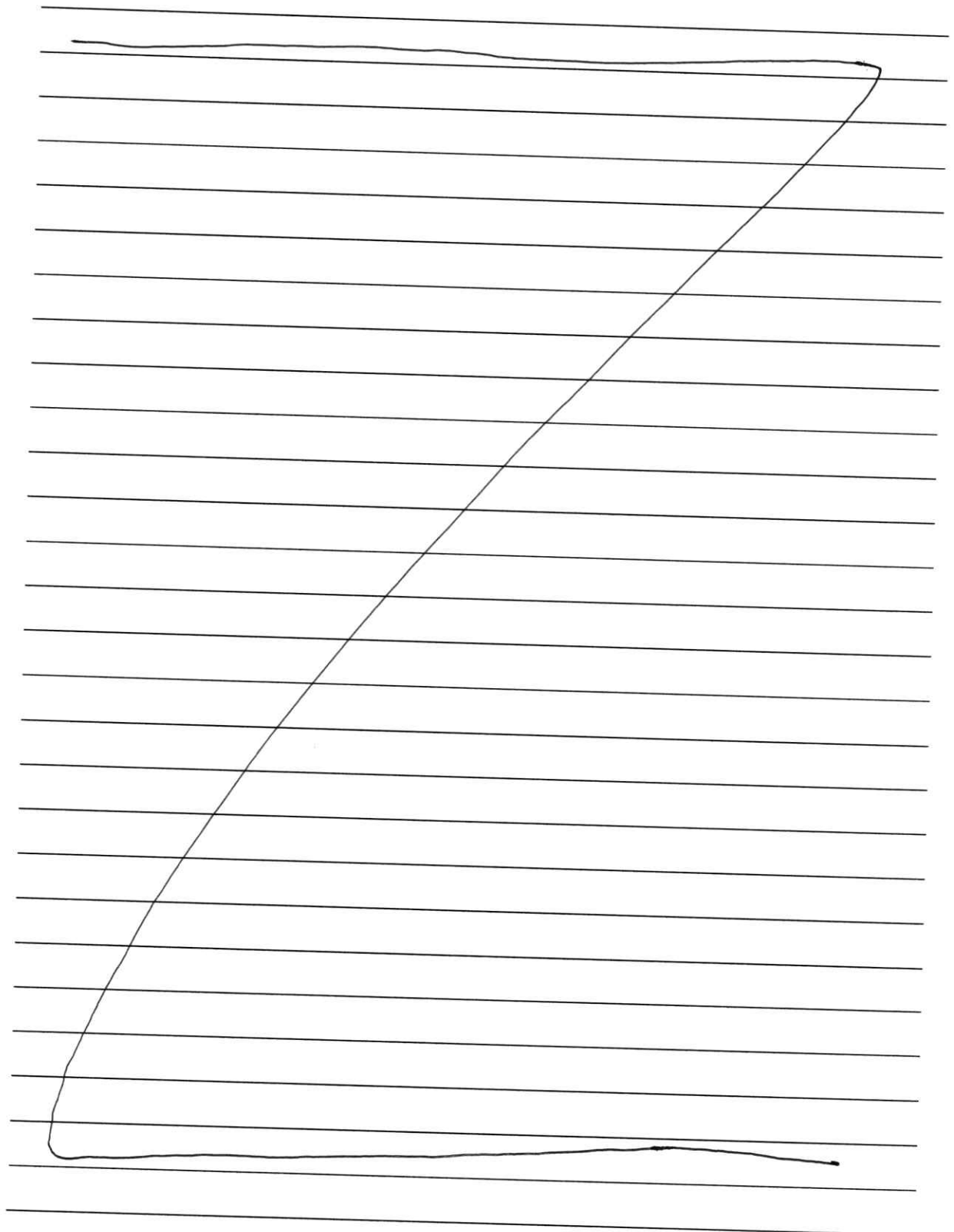
